III. Sirs, Nobles all:

I would like to give you an update on what has been happening in AFIFI.

As you may know the Divan has attended the PNSA and there are a number of things that came from that meeting. There were 3 members of the Imperial Divan at PNSA (Imperial Potentate) (Imperial Assistant Rabban} and (Imperial Outer Guard). There are a Number of takeaways that we came away with. (1)The Imperial Potentate made it very clear that the second section as we knew it is dead. There will be no Hazing of any kind or there will be severe consequences for any noble or Temple that is found to have participated in it.(2) There will be a Resolution presented this coming session that if a temple falls below 300 members its charter will be placed on hold for 3 years to bring the membership above 300 members or it may be forfeit. Having said this we will have to wait and see what the language will actually say in the call for 2022. (3) There will be a Resolution presented to increase the Per-capita to Imperial by \$20 per vear.

In consideration of what we learned, El Katif has invited Nile and Afifi to join them in an ad campaign that they produced last year for the East side of Washington State. If Nile and Afifi would join in the cost of this ad campaign it would be put out State wide in an effort to increase Membership. This was brought up at our last stated meeting and it was voted by the nobles at that meeting that we should provide \$5000.00 to this endeavor.

- The 2 new Australian fellows have arrived to the Shriners Children's Portland Hospital safely &
 we are excited to welcome them! The Portland Hospital is the only accredited hospital to train
 Australians in the US in pediatric orthopedics.
- 2. Upcomingeducation for providers:
 - A. Annual Dillahunt education programfor providers will be held on May6.
 - B. Our Primary Care Conference for pediatricians and family practice providers will be held on Aug.6.
- 3. Shriners Children's Portland board reviewed the 2021hospital results. Portland finished the year with outstanding quality & patient satisfaction! We even won the National Press Ganey award in Patient Experience.
- 4. 2021Portland achieved a record-breakingyear in reducing the reliance on our endowment decreasing by 60%. This allows us to extend our mission to provide more care to those children who do not have the ability to pay including patients throughout the Pacific Northwest and our international patients.
 - ♦ We are collaborating with Salt Lake City & Pasadena hospitals on caring for their patients from Mexico.
 - Shriners Children's Portland provides comprehensive care especially known for our spine, hip and chest wall services.
- The Shriners Children's Medford Clinic is the first off–site clinic outside of our four walls, allowing us to care for more kids in their own community in the Medford, Oregon area. Since opening in November, every single clinic has been full. What an honor to care for those children with unmet pediatric orthopedic needs!
- 6. Our first outreach clinic for 2021will be at our Bellingham Clinic on March 26, following that we will be in Anchorage, AK on April 30. Please let your family & friends in these areas know we are open to seeing both new and existing patients.
- 7. The walk-infracture & sports injury clinic has continued to grow exponentially, we have cared for 90% more kids in the clinic in the first two months of the year than we did in 2021. Please spread the word to your family & friends, we are open Monday-Friday (except holidays) 7:30am-4:00pm.
- 8. In 2022, Shriners International and Shriners Children's are celebrating very special anniversaries. Our fraternity was founded 150 years ago, and our health care system was established 100 years ago. Our marketing team has developed an anniversary toolkit for nobles to use to help honor and promote these major milestones. GUIDELINES FOR THE USE OF SOCIAL MEDIA

The following guidelines apply to the use of social media by all Nobles in their capacity as a Shriner, or in which one identifies himself as a Shriner through images or words on personal or public social media platforms and websites, as well as on behalf of all Shrine Associations, Temples, Units and Shrine Clubs. Nobles should always be aware that all electronic communications are permanent and may be made public, even if deleted.

Nothing in this section imposes any limitation on purely independent speech or E expression which is unrelated to the Shrine. Each member must determine for himself whether his personal communications or conduct, online or in person, meet the extremely high standards expected of a Shriner.

All internet and cellular phone based electronic communications must:

- 1. Be in compliance with and conform to the Code of Ethics of Shriners
- 2. Reflect positively on Shriners International and Shriners Hospitals for Children.
- 3. Not contain content or commentary that is antagonistic, bullying, confidential, defamatory, harassing, offensive, political, pornographic, profane, racially motivated or religious.
- 4. Not contain a third party's copyrighted material, trademarks, service marks or other protected material.
- 5. Not post private temple and fraternal matters on public facing social media. These matters include, but are not limited to:
- a. Legal, disciplinary, and personnel issues;
- b. A pending petition for membership of a particular candidate;
- c. Financial matters related to the fraternity or charity; and
- d. Fraternal or charitable legislative proposals, such as "the Call" for Imperial Sessions.
- 6. Be factually accurate and based on credible information. Acknowledge and correct mistakes promptly.
- 7. Adhere to the branding and stylistic guidelines contained in the Shriners International Fraternal Style Guide and the Shriners Hospitals for Children Identity Standards and Guidelines. These guidelines can currently be found on the Shriners International website in the members section.

In addition, all official Association, Temple, Unit and Shrine Club social media profiles, websites, and accounts must be accessible to and controlled by more than one administrator. Violation of these guidelines may be considered in determining whether such posts constitute conduct unbecoming a Noble.
