





Subject: Recent Article 30

Club or Unit President, please read the following communication at your next Club or Unit meeting. Thank you.

As many of you are aware, I recently addressed a serious issue involving an Article 30, brought by an Afifi Member. The charge was the use of racial slurs language in a conversation, which understandably offended the member. The Divan was promptly informed of Article 30 after the written and signed request was presented, and we made it clear that we would adhere to the guidelines established by Shriners' International Bylaws. The parties involved came to an agreement and resolved the Article 30. However, it is necessary for everyone to understand the gravity of this situation.

As members of the Ancient Arabic Order of the Nobles of the Mystic Shrine, we are holden to our Shriner's Creed and our Masonic Obligations. An obligation is a tie, pledge, or bond by which a man is tied to his fellows or gives his word to perform specific duties. We enter into these obligations of our own free will and accord.

Our Creed indicates that:

- 1. We, as individuals, pledge ourselves to integrity, virtue, and nobility of character.
- 2. Our intentions will be honorable, our relations will be trustworthy, and our spirits will be forgiving of each other.
- 3. As brothers, we offer each other fraternal affection and **respect**.

Our Masonic Obligations are not just words on a page, they are the foundation of our organization. They are founded on four important values that help define our path through life: Integrity, Friendship, Respect and Service. These principles, such as Fortitude, Prudence, Temperance, Justice, Brotherly Love, Relief, Truth, Liberty, Equality, and Fraternity, are not just ideals, they are the essence of who we are. They are our working tools, guiding us in our actions and decisions.

Given these values and expectations, any form of disrespect towards a fellow Noble will not be tolerated within our Temple nor jurisdiction.
